I hope you're all keeping up with your SPaG learning and developing your knowledge and understanding. You should now have done Step 1, Step 2 and Step 3 (we did Step 1 together in school although that feels like a very long time ago and you should have completed Steps 2 and 3 yourself at home) so now you can move on. If you are a bit behind don't worry, you can go back and re-do any Steps you're unsure about or haven't done yet until you've caught up to where you should be.

Year 3 have been learning about prepositions so you should be able to find:

The first part of each worksheet with red stars in the question boxes are easy ones to get you started, the second part with blue stars in the question boxes should make you think a little more carefully and the third section with the yellow stars in the question boxes is intended to be more of a challenge. Remember to read the instructions carefully in each section as they can change and become trickier as you work towards the yellow star questions.

Just like with all the other worksheets, the answers are at the end but do your best to have a go by yourself or with some adult help before looking at them. Go back to the powerpoint and look again at the examples on there if you're stuck. Once you have finished, maybe you can find a purple pen to mark and correct your work just like we would do in the classroom. Remember, you don't have to complete everything in one go, break it up over a few days and just do a little bit at a time.
