Differentiation:

Developing Questions to support spelling and using words ending in '–sure', '-ture' or '-cher'. Words are easily decodable (two syllable words), for example: puncture, butcher, richer, teacher, sure, future, mixture, stretcher.

Expected Questions to support spelling and using words ending in '-sure', '-ture' or '-cher'. Words are more difficult to decode (up to three syllable words), for example: creature, moisture, fracture, voucher, furniture, departure, pleasure, researcher, treasure.

Greater Depth Questions to support spelling and using words ending in '-sure', '-ture' or '-cher'. Words are more complex to decode and/or irregular, for example: misadventure, immature, enclosure, signature, architecture, temperature, leisure, sculpture. Some words taken from the Year 5/6 spelling lists.
