They will respond to a variety of texts that explore a range of different themes, that are relevant to the world in which they live.



Our KS3 curriculum is planned to scaffold and build confidence whilst developing necessary skills within Drama through team building during rehearsals, encouragement of performance or providing verbal feedback to their peers. The curriculum covers the key components of Drama and builds physical, vocal, communication, ensemble and creative skills, whilst exploring a range of different styles and practitioners.
