As a school

We will:

- ✓ Support your child's education, wellbeing and safety by providing a caring, creative and challenging learning environment in which all young people can thrive and succeed.
 - ✓ Provide a varied, balanced and creative curriculum, which meets the needs and abilities of our pupils and students, reflects our setting and enables pupils and students to develop their talents and skills to the highest standard.
 - ✓ Monitor and update you on your child's progress at calendared parent meetings and in written reports.
 - ✓ Communicate any concerns about your child's attendance, behaviour or wellbeing with you as their parent/carer.
 - ✓ Respond to communications from parents in a timely manner, following school policies.
 - ✓ Promote high standards of behaviour, and outline clear expectations in our behaviour policy so we can maintain a safe environment for all children.
 - ✓ Set homework that supports the delivery of the curriculum and prepares our young people for future higher education and careers.
 - ✓ Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life.
 - ✓ Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, email, social media and the school website.
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Parents/carers

I will:

- ✓ Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time. I will notify the school if my child will be absent.

- ✓ Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and brings the necessary equipment to school.
 - ✓ Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour.
 - ✓ Encourage my child to try their best so that they can reach their full potential.
 - ✓ Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn.
 - ✓ Make sure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff.
 - ✓ Understand that I should communicate with staff during core school hours, and although they may at times respond outside of those hours, I can't expect that.
 - ✓ Make sure that my child completes their homework on time and raises any issues with their teachers.
 - ✓ Read and follow the school's policies.
 - ✓ Treat all members of the school community with care and respect.
 - ✓ Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
 - ✓ Read any communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary.
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Pupils and Students

I will:

- ✓ Arrive at school and my lessons every day on time and ready to learn.
- ✓ Show courage and commitment in my learning and ask for help if I need it.
- ✓ Complete my homework on time and raise any issues with my teachers.
- ✓ Speak to an adult about any issues I'm experiencing that may affect my work or behaviour.
- ✓ Speak to an adult about any concerns I have about my or other pupils' safety.
- ✓ Wear the correct school uniform.
- ✓ Bring to school all the equipment I need each day.
- ✓ Treat all members of the school community with care and respect.
- ✓ Understand and follow the school behaviour policy.
- ✓ Look after school equipment, and show respect for the school environment and local community.
