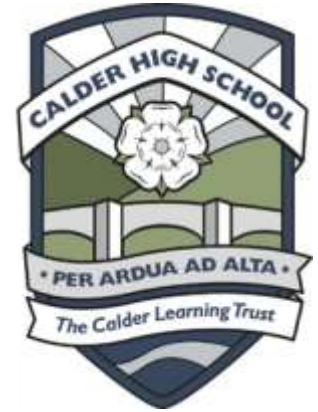

Simply:

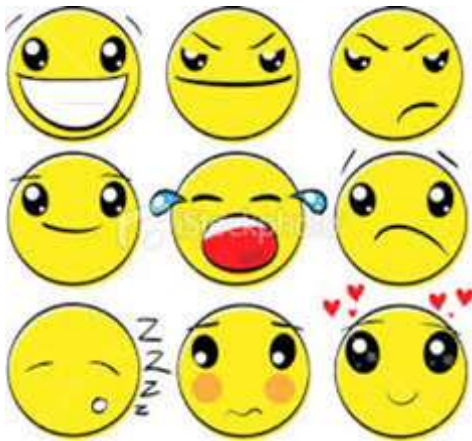
- **Care** - be polite and show respect to both staff and other students (whether they are your friends or not!)

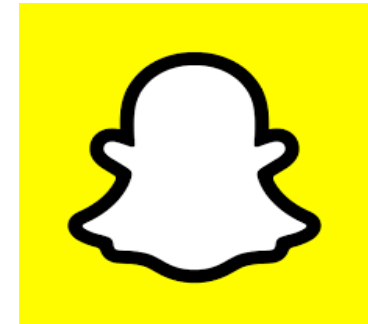
