Class News

Class R In maths this week we have been taking away. We played lots of different games and the children have done a super job. In topic The Gingerbread Man has visited India, China, Australia, Brazil and the USA. We found the countries on the map and talked about how he might have travelled from country to country. We also tried some Bhangra dancing, said hello and goodbye in Mandarin and tried some Samba dancing. On Friday we got to spend time with our buddies, which we loved!

Class 1 This week Class 1 have been super busy! In maths, Y2 have been continuing their amazing work on fractions, finding halves, quarters, and thirds! Y1 have been making equal groups and sharing amounts. In science we have been learning about forces- we explored and investigated how a force can change a solid. We squeezed, bent, squished, twisted, and stretched a range of different objects to see which ones changed shape! In DT the children have worked super hard with their puppets. Throughout the term we planned, designed, practised techniques, made a range of puppets and then finally made our own hand puppets. This afternoon we will be finishing them off and planning/rehearsing our own puppet show.

Class 2 Class 2 have had a great week this week. In English we have written and edited our setting descriptions. We included fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, rhetorical questions and even similes and metaphors! In maths we have begun our time unit. We are working on telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes and converting time from analogue clocks to digital clocks. In PE we have competed in some very competitive games of rounders and we now know the rules of how to get each other out and how to score the game. In science we investigated physical and chemical changes. We used different chemicals and observed how they reacted with each other. In geography we have created a poster showing how indigenous live in the Amazon Rainforest. A super week everyone, well done!

Class 3 This week Year 5 have been busy developing their angles skills by using protractors to measure and draw angles. They have also worked in groups to design an advertising campaign for a brand-new chocolate bar. They have looked at examples of persuasive writing and what type of vocabulary they would need to use for their target audience. They have even blind taste tested some chocolate too! In science we have looked at how an object in motion can have multiple forces acting upon it at one time and in topic we used our tropical rainforest writing to help us compare to other biomes! Finally, in PE we tried a mini-match in cricket and worked on our vault skills in gymnastics! What a busy week!

We have had a big equipment order arrive this week with lots of new athletics and playtime equipment for our Active Leaders to start thinking about what they could organise with it.



