# **Class News**

**Class R** This week, Reception have been learning about habitats. We started our week by reading 'The Squirrels Who Squabbled' and discussed where the story is set (woodland) and what other animals we would find in that habitat. We made bird and squirrel feeders for the local animals that live in the woodland around our playground by threading cheerios onto a pipe cleaner; we counted how many cheerios we used and discussed the size of our pipe cleaners, ordering them from longest to shortest. We also discussed which animals live where and why. We wondered if a lion would survive in a polar habitat? Miss Appleyard had set up a polar habitat in our tuff tray which had a range of animals but they were stuck in the ice! We had to perform an animal rescue and try to save them!

**Class 1** In science we have classified animals based on what they eat. We looked at the teeth of a variety of animals and discussed why some need sharper teeth than others. We used hula hoops to create a venn diagram and sorted animals in to carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. In maths we have been using place value charts and part whole models to identify and partition numbers in different ways. In literacy, year 2 have been finding out how to use a thesaurus to help add interest to their writing. In history we found out more about what happened during the Great Fire of London, talked about how we know about the events of 1666 and found out who Samuel Pepys was. Our nativity rehearsals are going well and it is fantastic to see how much work some of the children are putting in at home to learn their lines. Well done Class 1!

**Class 2** This week Class 2 have been busy putting their compass skills to the test by completing some orienteering this week in forest school! In history we looked at how life in Britain changed during the Iron Age and in English we have finished our explanation texts of The Stone Age which we can't wait to share! Finally, in DT we have collected all of our questionnaire data to help us decide on ingredients for our soups! We are exciting to trial our recipes soon!
