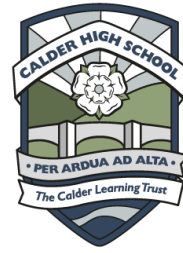
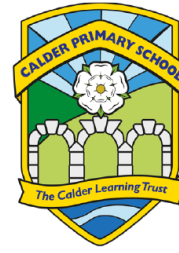

The ParentPay link is a charity link, so you are also able to add gift aid if you are eligible and ParentPay do not take any of the money raised. In addition, this link does not require a ParentPay account to donate so if you would like to share it with friends and family to support your child in their Bearpees challenge, please do so!

We will be able to separate donations from Calder High's fundraising, so that our Calder Primary School Council can see how much they have raised too.

For the cake sale, please bring 50p in cash to buy a cake on Friday if you would like to take part.
