Maths – Year 1 and 2

Can you write numbers up to twenty? How high can you go? Can you write the numbers in words?

Year 1 – Maths

Can you write out the number bonds to 10? E.g. 10+0, 9+1 etc. Can you write any of the number bonds to 20? You could use counters, lego bricks or something similar to help you.

Year 2 – Maths

First write out the number bonds to 10. E.g. 10+0, 9+1 etc. Can you use this to help you write out some number bonds to 100? E.g. 100+0, 90+10.

Can you explain how these calculations are similar? Can you explain how they are different?
