On Thursday, our usual lessons are Maths, Library, Phonics/Literacy, Music and RE. Here are some suggested activities to complete. If you didn't manage to complete any of the tasks from Monday, you could do those instead of the ones outlined below.

Maths – Thursday is Numeracy Ninja Day!

If you are able to complete any of your Numeracy Ninja sheets bring them in to school to make sure you get your sticker from Miss Moran! You could also make a note of how long it took you to complete it if you timed yourself. You don't need to print the sheets – answers can be written on any paper you have at home.

Year 1 Numeracy Ninjas

You have 2 sets of question. You could challenge yourself and set a timer to see how quickly you can complete the questions.

- Class 1 Number Bonds to 10
- Class 1 Mixed Addition and Subtraction Year 1

Year 2 Numeracy Ninjas

You have 2 sets of question. You could challenge yourself and set a timer to see how quickly you can complete the questions.

- Mixed Addition and Subtraction

Maths – Year 1 and 2 (additional task/activity if needed-repeated from Monday)

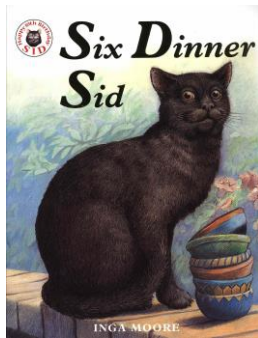
