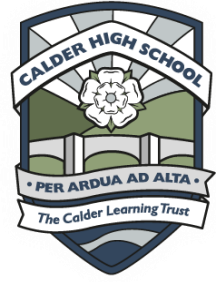
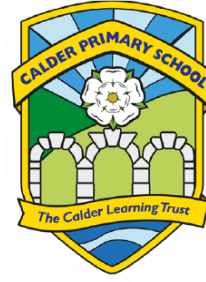

Christmas Nativity Concert 2024

Dear Parents / Carers,

Our Christmas Nativity this year is called 'Christmas Counts' and features all our pupils: Classes R and 1 will be performing the Nativity and Classes 2 and 3 sharing a Christmas story and some Christmas songs. Our choir will also be singing.

There will be two performances on **Wednesday 11th December at 2pm and 6pm in The Calder Learning Trust Theatre**. For the 2pm performance please come straight to the Calder High main entrance from 1.50pm (accessed via gates on either Midgley Road or Brier Hey Lane – please press the buzzer and explain you are coming to the Nativity) and take your seats in the theatre. Unfortunately, you will not be able to get through the Appleyard Road gate at this time.

For the **6pm performance, please return to school for 5.40pm** and come straight to the Calder High main entrance for the Ted Hughes Theatre (all the site gates will be open at this time so you can also access this via the Appleyard Road entrance as well) Pupils will be met by teachers to go and get ready and families can take their seats. If you are not watching this performance, please collect your child from here at approximately 6.45pm.

We hope that all pupils will be able to return for the evening performance, but if they are unable to do so, please let us know as soon as possible as it will affect roles and rehearsals.
