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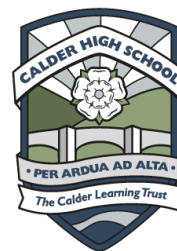
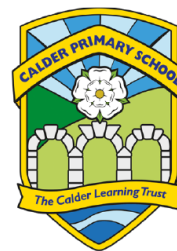

Spring Term Clubs

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to confirm the spring term clubs at Calder Primary.

- **Newspaper Club** - Years 3-6 Wednesdays 12pm in the music room
- **Choir** – Years 2-6 Tuesdays 12pm in Class 1
- **Dodgeball** – Years 3-6, Mondays 3.15-4.15pm in the hall (until 18/3/24)- there is a charge for this club and it has already begun, but if you want to enquire about a late place, please speak to Mrs Pickup.
- **Cookery** – Years 1 and 2, Wednesdays 3.15-4.15pm from 21/2/24 for 4 weeks. There is a charge of £3 per session towards ingredients (£12 in total) please see the letter when it is sent out.
- **CHS Band, Choir and Sports Clubs** – continue to be available to Year 6 – please see Miss Smith for details.
- **Judo** – Years 4 and 5 initially – 3.15-4.15pm Tuesdays from 20/2/24 for 5 weeks. There will be a charge for this club, please see the letter after Judo Excellence have visited.
- **Reception Club** – pending for after half term. We are just confirming the details.

Please note that some clubs have a maximum number of participants possible and these will be on a first come, first served basis with a waiting list if needed. If you do not hear anything after you have signed up, you can assume you have a place. If the club is full, you will be notified.

We ask pupils to commit to attending for the term (it is a short term) to help staff with pupil numbers and planning. You do not need to email us for lunchtime clubs, children can go along and sign up with the staff.

Letters will be sent out for Cookery and Judo Club with all the details and how to sign up shortly, as these clubs begin after half term and Judo Excellence are coming in to tell the children more about it on 6th February first!

We are always keen to hear of new ideas for clubs- Judo and Cookery were suggested by our pupils and brought to school council. If these are successful, we plan to offer them to other year groups later in the year too.
