We have an allotment. Earlier this year, we did some bird watching at our allotment.



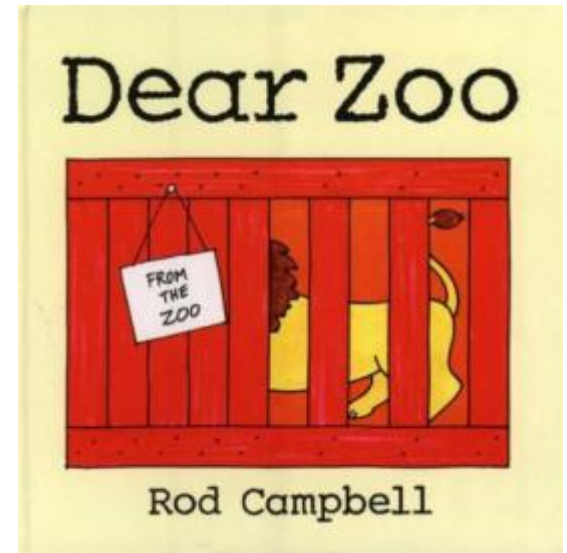
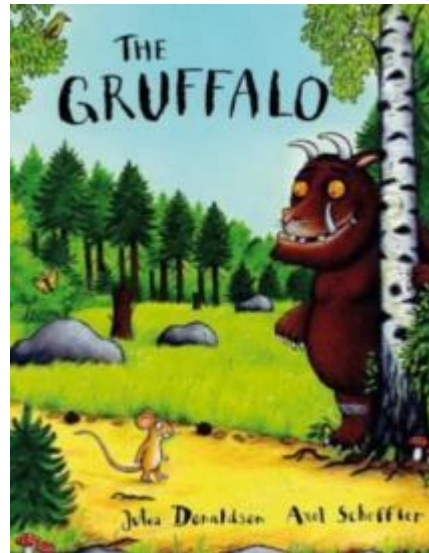
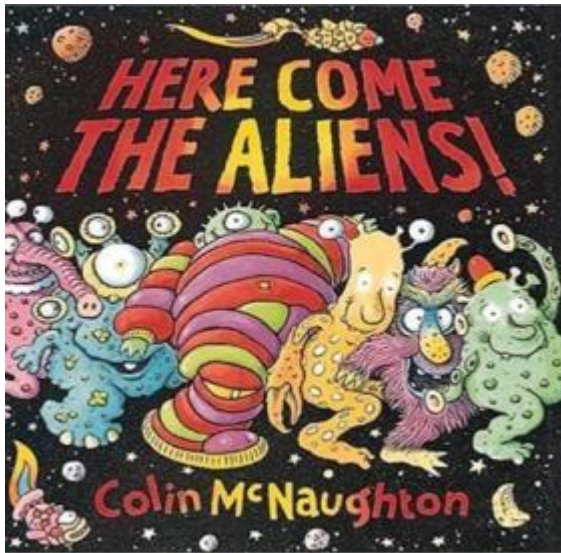
Throughout the year we have many special events and celebrations; Nativity, Guy Making, World Book Day and Red Nose Day.
