



## Calder Primary School 2018-2019 Key Stage 1 Data

We are very proud of all our pupils who have worked incredibly hard and achieved some amazing progress and results this year.

At the end of Year 2, pupils finish Key Stage 1 and are assessed in Reading, Writing and Maths. Judgements are reached through a mixture of formal testing and the Class Teacher's knowledge of the child. Pupils are assessed as either 'Working Towards the Expected Standard', 'Working At the Expected Standard' or 'Working At Greater Depth Within the Expected Standard'. This table shows the percentage of our Year 2 pupils that are 'Working At the Expected Standard' or 'Working At Greater Depth Within the Expected Standard' and how this compares to the percentage of pupils achieving this both across Calderdale and Nationally.
